Sailing Instructions

Standard club courses will be used (<http://www.dee-sc.co.uk/docs/2004/CourseCard%202004%20v12.pdf>), with the intention of setting three races of three laps each as follows:

- 1) Windward / Leeward bias
- 2) Long Distance (using the longest course available, appropriate to the conditions, with a balance of windward/leeward and reaching)
- 3) Reaching bias

6 Schedule of Races

- 6.1 The LBSA race is scheduled to start at 10:55am on 4 September 2005. Catamarans will start 3 minutes after the LBSAs. Dinghies will start 3 minutes after the Catamarans.
- 6.2 Race 2 will start as soon as practical after the first race and Race 3 will start as soon as practical after Race 2.

7 Class Flags

- 7.1 Class flags will be:
 - 7.1.1 Catamarans – E
 - 7.1.2 Dinghies – H

13 Time Limits

- 13.1 Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish.

15 Scoring

- 15.2 Handicapping for Catamarans will be in accordance with SCHRS. Details can be found at <http://www.schrs.com/schrsratings.asp?id=all>

Dinghies will use PY numbers.

17 Replacement of Crew or Equipment

- 17.1 The boat, helm & crew officially enter the competition. Substitution of competitors will be allowed at the sole discretion of the Race Officer and will only be allowed in case of injury.
- 17.2 No redress or adjustment to handicap will be given for loss of, or damage to equipment after the start of the first race – for example, in the case of removal of a spinnaker.
